Collaborative partner students should contact their own institutions Student Services in the first instance should they require information or advice on financial matters. However collaborative students can also access support at the University.

Money and Welfare provide advice to students on all aspects of money matters including:

- ☐ **Access to Learning Fund**
- ☐ **The FE Learner Support Fund**
- ☐ **Budgeting / Debt**
- ☐ **Sources of Funding**

The 'ASK Here' service runs from 9am to 5pm, Monday to Friday so that students with quick queries or emergencies can be sure of seeing an advisor the same day for a 10 or 15 minute slot. If a student has a more in depth case and needs more time, they can book a longer appointment. Money Doctors appointments offer budgeting advice, help with local authority or Student Loans Company queries for example. Welfare Officer appointments offer in depth advice and guidance on debt issues, welfare issues etc.
