He is an experienced presenter having given over 300 presentations around the world since 1995. His main research area is in learning and teaching in HE. Mick has led several major government funded projects, and he is Co-Director of an ESRC project on “Enhancing the quality and outcomes of disabled students’ learning in higher education”. He will speak on 'disability and learning difference'.
