

THE FACULTY OF HEALTH AND LIFE SCIENCES INTERNATIONAL ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP 2014/2015

The Faculty of Health and Life Sciences is pleased to announce the launch of the International Alumni Scholarships 2014/2015 for full-time students who have achieved at least a 2:2 in their undergraduate degree. This award is part of the Faculty's on-going commitment to enhancing the personal and career development of our own graduates.

The scholarship is based on academic achievement and merit and applies automatically to all DMU overseas status students who expect to graduate this Summer (2014) or who have graduated within the last two years (2012 or 2013). Eligible students will also have achieved at least a 2:2 and subsequently enroll onto one of our full-time master's degrees in 2014/2015

Students who hold a 2.1 or First Class Honours degree are eligible for a £2000 discount on the 2014/2015 tuition fees for a full-time Masters programme

Students who hold a 2:2 honours degree qualification will be eligible for a £1000 discount on the 2014/2015 tuition fees for a full-time Masters programme

Terms and conditions:

- Scholarships are available for full-time taught Master's courses running in the 2014/15 academic session
- The scholarship will operate as a tuition fee discount only, to be applied at the point of enrolment.
- The scholarship is valid only for entry into the 2014/2015 academic session – scholarships cannot be deferred by the applicant until a subsequent academic year.
- Applicants must be currently studying or have previously studied at DMU and successfully completed a course (in any subject), with at least a 2:2. The course must be a least nine months in duration (full-time, part-time or distance learning) and must have been studied at a DMU UK campus
- All DMU graduates from the UK and EU are eligible, including students graduating in 2014 or those who have graduated within the last two years (2011/2012 or 2012/2013)
- Applicants must have no outstanding debt to the university
- Students in receipt of the scholarship will not be eligible for any other scholarship or award. No cash alternatives will be offered and the scholarship cannot be transferred to any other course at DMU or to a nominated recipient
- Scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the university
- De Montfort University (DMU) reserves the right to revise, review or withdraw any of the scholarships at any time without prior notice.
- Scholarships are only available to students paying their own fees
- De Montfort University (DMU) reserves the right to cancel any scholarship which has been claimed fraudulently and to apply the full tuition fee.
- Where a student terminates or interrupts their studies, prior to the completion of their course, both the tuition fees and the scholarship will be pro-rated, based on the student's last date of attendance.
- Where a student changes their mode of study from full-time to part-time, the Alumni Scholarship will be pro-rated based on the effective change date. The part-time scholarship will then be applied to the fees pro-rata.
